The College leads the country in the photojournalism category of the Hearst competition.

This is the result of two photojournalism seniors placing in the first round of the contest. **Tim Hussin** won second place and \$1,500, and **Jeremiah Wilson** won seventh place and \$500.

Hussin will continue as one of 12 semifinalists with a chance at the shoot-out in San Francisco in June.

The students submitted photographs they had shot for internships, the *Independent Florida Alligator* and course assignments.

John Freeman selected their entries after consulting with faculty members, newspaper photo directors and former Hearst winners.

The College is now preparing for the second round of the Hearst photojournalism competition.

Professor prepares people for pre-press

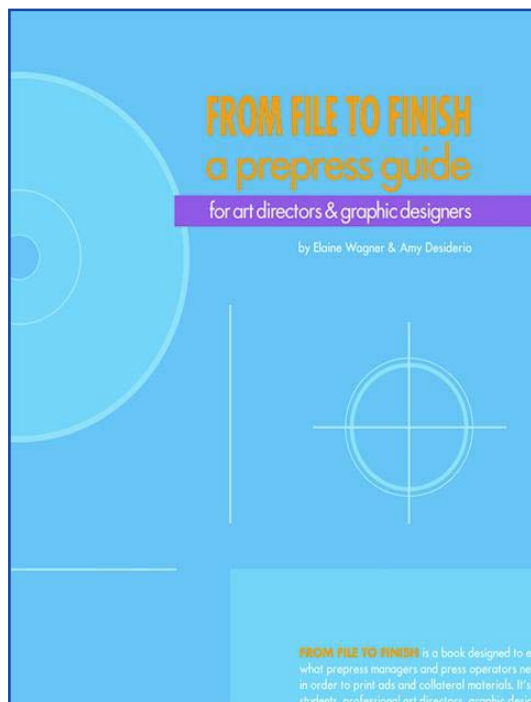
