

University of Florida Foreign Language Admissions Requirement

Students must have successfully completed two years of one foreign language at the secondary level (high school), or 8 to 10 semester hours at the postsecondary level or passed exams in CLEP, AP, IB or UF departmental proficiency exams.

College Foreign Language Requirement* and/or Quantitative Option**

Students who have taken two years of a foreign language in high school or have otherwise met the university requirement have the following options: taking further courses in that language, selecting a different language if the last course in a beginning-level sequence is completed, or taking 8 hours of the quantitative option courses below:
