Chance updated on Faculty Welfare committee. She reported re-institution of professional summer opportunities. Some other ideas/thoughts: break space with computers, get more information for more supportive and transparent mentoring process (including mentoring award); support for adjunct instructors; conversation toward re-norming college culture to talk about service being one of two that would be suitable for our College. Walsh-Childers reported that two task forces are on T&P committee—grants and guidelines for promotion for non-tenure-accruing faculty. Also, how can we be more effective teachers with international students? Walsh-Childers reminded of boot camp for international grad students.
