Curriculum and Teaching Annual Report 2015-2016

The Curriculum and Teaching Committee of the College of Journalism and Communication has several primary purposes, including:

- Reviewing curriculum proposals and new courses recommended by the departments
- Reviewing academic assessment data and recommending changes based on the review
- Proposing changes to college-level rules, policies, regulations, and procedures as they relate to curriculum and teaching
- Recommending individuals for Teacher of the Year, Faculty Adviser of the Year, and Adviser of the Year.

In addition to our normal duties, the committee reviewed curriculum changes and course proposals from Telecommunication, course proposals from Journalism, and changes to the third English class requirement from Advertising, Public Relations, and Telecommunication.

The committee also proposed consolidations in critical tracking courses for all four departments, which the departments subsequently had approved.

The committee nominated Deanna Pelfrey as Teacher of the Year, James Babanikos as Faculty Adviser of the Year, and Judy Hunter as Adviser of the Year.
