Our Committee met four times this year academic and generated the following accomplishments.

- 1) In January, we hosted invited Dr. Thomasina Adams-Lott, Associate Dean for Research and Faculty Development, Office of Educational Research, College of Education, who made a presentation to our faculty on best practices for building a more supportive and transparent mentoring process for our faculty in the promotion and tenure process, including teaching. - 2) We secured the re-institution of the Professional Summer Award and the Research Summer Award, which were allocated to two faculty members for Summer 2016.
