Excerpts paraphrased from the UF Admissions website: Students in the PaCE program must accept the PaCE admissions offer and return the contract and tuition deposit, complete the online orientation, meet with an adviser, and enroll for at least two semesters and a minimum of 15 credits through UFOnline. PaCE students must earn a total of 60 credits, complete prerequisite or tracking courses, and maintain the required GPA designated by the major. Once all requirements are met, PaCE students complete a transition form to move to a guaranteed place on the UF residential campus to complete the degree.

REQUIRED Critical Tracking GPA for all majors in the CJC:

Semester 1: 2.0 GPA on all work at all institutions

Semesters 2 through 5: 2.0 GPA required for all critical tracking courses and 2.5 GPA on all work at all institutions
