

**Minutes, Deans and Chairs Meeting
March 23, 2020, via Zoom**

McFarlin called the meeting to order at 2 p.m.

COVID-19 Update and Discussion

- Diane McFarlin said UF has confirmed there are two CJC cases: an employee and a student. She said that the college will make communications as swift as possible.
- Keisha Reynolds discussed essential personnel.
- McFarlin discussed AID-A-GATOR, UF Food Pantry, and other resources to help students with emergency financial challenges.
- McFarlin said it is too early to discuss the Tenure & Promotion clock and that there is an extension process if needed.
- Spiro Kiouisis said the student summer fees are staying status-quo, and the College is assessing equipment fees.
- James Babanikos said the Provost expects all classes will be SU eligible, or there should be a very good reason for not allowing SU. Students will make their choice online. SU is not pass/fail, an S is a C or better, U is C- or lower. At the graduate level, the SU option will be determined at the college level with Graduate School input.
- Ted Spiker asked about policy around need to report students sick, but not yet being tested. Reynolds suggested they should contact the UF Student Health Care Center Special Clinics Nurse.

McFarlin thanked the Deans and Chairs and closed the meeting.
