How do I add a minor?

1. Check the minor required classes here:

3. Fill it out (make sure it is signed at the bottom) and email it to advising@jou.ufl.edu. **Please include your UFID# and major in the email as well.**
4. Get the signature from the advisor of the minor you desire.
