Master’s Students:

Only graduate-level (5000-7999) work with a grade of B or better is eligible for transfer of credit.

A maximum of 9 transfer credits are allowed from institutions approved by UF. Credits transferred from other universities are applied toward the degree requirements, but grades earned are not computed in the student’s GPA.

Combination Degree Program Students:

Master’s students who took part in the combination degree program can transfer up to 12 graduate credits taken while an undergraduate student to count toward their degree. Only graduate-level (5000-7999) work with a grade of B or better is eligible for transfer of credit. The transfer of credit request should be completed in the student’s first semester as a master’s student.
