Announcements/Updates

- The mid-semester senate-called faculty meeting is planned for Wednesday, November 16, at 4:00 PM in Gannett Auditorium.
- The next UCC meeting is Tuesday, November 15th, so we won't be able to make that meeting. However, I'm hoping we'll be able to get everything in so we can get these changes approved in the December UCC meeting, which meets on Tuesday, December 13th.
- Remind faculty to apply for the Teacher / Faculty mentor / Adjunct Instructor of the Year. Applications are due on November 28th.
- From the ACUA meeting:
 - o Academic calendar update: Homecoming 2023 (October 7, 2023), Spring Break 2023 (March 11-18, aligns with ACPS), Juneteenth on June 10th, 2023... June 10th is a Saturday!!!
 - o A lot of questions regarding the Self Care Class Note in the Self Care Resources website <https://shcc.ufl.edu/self-care/>. The faculty across campus seems to be as cynical as the faculty here at the CJC. One suggestion was that this would be available to students only in peak times when appointments are hard to come by in the Student Health Center. More to follow.

Discussion Items

The C & T Committee approved to:

- Reduce the number of credit hours from 124 to 120 hours for the four CJC undergrad majors.
- **In Journalism:**

- Change the number of JOU Core Credits from 32 – 27.
 - Have students take 12 credits (up from 6) in one of 6 proposed specializations:
 - Broadcast
 - Visual
 - Writing/Reporting
 - Editing/Producing
 - Data/Coding
 - Customized
 - Change the number of CJC electives from 14 to 13 credits.
 - Change the number of Outside Concentration credits from 12 to 9.
 - Change the pre-reqs to 10 courses.
 - Create permanent course numbers for 9 classes.
- **In Journalism – Sports and Media**
- Change the number of JOU Core Credits from 17 – 20.
 - Change the number of JOU Sports Courses from 21 to 18.
 - Change the number of Outside Concentration credits from 12 to 9.
 - Change the number of UF electives from 8 to 7.
- **In MPMT**
- Change the names of 7 courses to reflect the change in the department’s name.
