2022-2023 Reporter to College Faculty Senate

Members: Andrew G Selepak (MPMT), Mark Leeps (JOU), Anne Searight Christiano (PUR), Santiago Kember (Chair, ADV), Brian Krieger (TAG), (PUR), and Josh Merrill (TAG).

On September 21, 2022, the committee met for the first time during the semester. Josh Merrill walked the committee through what the focus of previous years had been:

- Transition to technical support and transition some CJC classrooms to the UF support team.
- Previously the committee has discussed and shared with the College student's needs, student computing requirements, and awareness of risk assessment with software.

Kember was elected as chair. Kember agreed to meet with Dr. Spiro, Executive Associate Dean, to inquire about expectations for the committee during the academic year.

On October 27, 2022, Santiago Kember met with Dr. Kiouisis regarding the committee. Dr. Kiouisis requested the committee to focus on a recommendation for computer replacement cycles for the college.

On February 27, 2023, Kember and Merrill met; Merrill shared the process and funding sources for computer replacement for faculty and staff and a tentative plan to refresh the current systems over five years and then continue with a 5-year refresh cycle for all CJC computing systems. Discussions around technological improvements and software needs led to the goal of shortening the refresh recycle to an average of 4 years instead of 5.

On February 28, 2023, Merrill and Kember agreed on the Policy recommendation to allow the renewal of faculty and staff PCs every four years on average, which was included in the TAG Strategic Plan 2023 submitted on March 1st, 2023.
