Telling Our Story: With Cloe Zeidan, created one set of presentation slides for CJC international study and internships abroad, and another for CJC staff presenting on our college in other parts of the world.

Partner University of Dubrovnik: Facilitated faculty exchange for Profs Coche, Camaj and McNealy to visit and chose two CJC students from 23 applicants to study abroad in Croatia in spring 2025.

New partner HDM in Stuttgart, Germany: Completed CJC's Memorandum of Understanding w/ HdM, now open to CJC students for semester-long exchanges that could include work w/ Mercedes and Porche. Committee chair Barnett tabled at HdM's International Education Week in November and connected w/ HdM faculty on international journalistic projects. CJC reps Coche, Zeidan and Barnett and Path Office met with HdM faculty and administrators in April to brainstorm additional projects.

UF International Education Week: The committee hosted a successful Global Potluck in November to celebrate CJC's international students; hear their travel tales; and share heritage meals cooked by faculty, staff and students. We plan to make it an annual event.
