Minutes of Meeting

1. Welcome & New Member Introductions

Meeting started at 9:30AM.

2. Selection of international committee chair

Williams nominates Barnett as chair, Alexandrino moves, Spiker seconds, and Barnett is approved unanimously.

3. Selection of Date for CJC International Potluck lunch during UF International Education

Week 11/17-11/21/25

Barnett recommends 11/18/25 as the international potluck.date. The Dean's Office has agreed to fund a portion of the food. Lee recommends using more of an open space, so people can mingle more easily. The inclusion of the tiny tales component makes technology necessary, so Weimer 3032 may be more effective. Lee thinks using the Atrium would allow for more visibility, and the technology hurdles would be surmountable. Zeidan moves for 11/18/25 11-130 to be the date, Alexandrino seconds, and the vote passes unanimously. Barnett will follow up with Jess Osegueda to see if the Atrium would be an option for the meeting site.

Zeidan states there will be resources published on the CJC website with resources for international students.
