

2026-27 PaCE TRANSITION REQUIREMENTS

PaCE students who began at UF in fall 2026 must complete these requirements prior to transitioning:

- earn a total of 60 credits (this can include credits earned through dual enrollment and AICE, AP, CLEP and IB exam scores)
- earn a minimum critical tracking and UF GPA of 2.0
- complete at least 2 semesters and 15 credits through the UF Online program
- pass (typically a minimum grade of 'C' unless noted otherwise) all major-specific transition courses (listed below)

***Note: The MPMT department prefers that students on the Digital Film and TV Production track take RTV 2517. Students on the Media Management and Technology track can take RTV 2517 or VIC 3001.*

PR majors – AMH 2020, ENC 3252, foreign language/quantitative option, general education, MMC 2121, MMC 3203, PUR 3211, SPC 2608
